ACADEMIC BACKGROUND

Regarding my studies, I earned a grade point average (GPA) of 2.55 while completing the Secondary Education Examination (SEE) at Basbitti Ma Vi in Basantapur, Mahottari, Nepal in 2018 A.D. I then graduated with a diploma in civil engineering from Aadikabi Bhanubhakta Secondary School in Bharatpur, Chitwan, in 2022 A.D. with first division obtaining 73.58% percentage where my registration number is DCE-02361-018.

GAP EXPLANATION

Between my academic careers, there is no hiatus. I started taking PTE classes after finishing my higher level education. Although I finished my PTE course in a month, I spent some time to study and worked hard to get better results. On April 22, 2023 A.D., I took the test and received an overall score of 49 (Listening- 46, Reading- 47, Speaking- 51, and Writing- 47).

REASONS FOR NOT CHOOSING NEPAL FOR FURTHER STUDY

Beautiful Nepal is home to people from many different languages and cultural backgrounds. The majority of students who wish to excel academically opt to study abroad for the following reasons, notwithstanding the pleasant climate:

- The education system is not convenient

- Subpar amenities and inadequate infrastructure

REASONS FOR NOT CHOOSING OTHER COUNTRIES

Although there are many areas where I could apply for a bachelor's degree, I haven't yet chosen countries like the United States, the United Kingdom, or other European nations for a variety of reasons.

USA: Attending American universities is prohibitively expensive. The requirement to take SAT classes in addition to the high expense of tuition is the main deterrent for many students from choosing to study in the United States. UK: The country's tuition fee protection plan (TPS) is still an issue, and living costs are considerable. It has been in operation from the first of July, 2016. I am aware of the following requirements for students holding a higher education visa under subclass 500:

- I have to keep my course attendance rate at 80% for the duration of the term.
- Upon enrolling, I am not permitted to switch education providers for six months, and if I do, I must get a letter of release from the first education provider.
- I must have overseas student health insurance (OHSC) for the length of my stay in Australia, and I must pay my tuition cost by the deadline.
- Until I leave Australia, I must keep up a sufficient level of health insurance.
- I have to keep my pass rate at 50% throughout the duration of my study time.
- I am able to work part-time for 40 hours every two weeks.
- Within seven days of any changes to my address or contact information, I must tell my college.
- I am fully aware of all the requirements for maintaining my visa.
- I must maintain my health insurance till I leave Australia. I must refrain from acting violently or aggressively in a way that might harm the Australian community or a segment of it.
